According to a recent report by data platform Tracxn, India has seen the emergence of over 8,000 tech-based startups founded by women, collectively raising nearly USD 23 billion in funding. This figure represents a noteworthy 14.8 per cent share of the overall tech funding in the country, reflecting the growing influence and success of women founders in the ecosystem.

Of these 8,000 startups, 2,316 have successfully secured funding, demonstrating investor confidence in the potential and innovation brought forth by women entrepreneurs. Despite the vast number of unfunded startups, a substantial 590 companies have achieved revenues exceeding USD 30,000, signalling their sustainability and growth prospects in the market.

However, the less encouraging news reveals a stark reality. Despite their significant contributions, women entrepreneurs continue to face systemic barriers, particularly in accessing venture capital funding. Shockingly, less than 3 per cent of the VC funding goes to women in the country, according to the Encubay report.

Given tumultuous times in India's startup ecosystem where funding dryness looms large, these women left no stone unturned to make lives better for customers in various reigns. Across sectors, these women are the innovators and disruptors who are rewriting the rulebook. These women changemakers are not only offering innovation-led solutions for gaps across sectors but also contributing immensely to India's economic growth story.
